
Fred Victor Centre-BUS provides a safe accessible shelter for men and women, who are homeless, socially isolated, and who have difficulty maintain housing elsewhere. The individuals that require emergency shelter and access our services may have been recently evicted, victims of domestic violence, be coping with mental health or substance use, unemployed, new immigrants/refugees, or those who have experienced trauma. Additionally, our shelter is unique in that we serve Trans women and men, people with pets, and couples.

We provide short-term overnight accommodation and intensive case management and various programming to 70 individuals. Clients have access to three nutritious meals a day, a weekly in-house-medical clinic, harm reduction information, assistance gaining employment, and housing access and advocacy.

Your contribution is greatly appreciated and is instrumental in helping us provide resources to everyone that uses our services. It makes a difference in a person's life and shows your compassion for the vulnerable population we serve.
